Kārearea (New Zealand falcon)

Falco novaeseelandiae





Characteristics

The kārearea are one of our fastest manu, and is only found in Aotearoa. They are capable of speeds up to 200 km/h — that's twice as fast as the cars on the motorway!

Kārearea are super strong. They hunt live prey and can catch prey even larger than themselves. It's rare for a falcon to hunt in forested AND open land but kārearea does. One day you may watch them do a spectacular stooping dive to catch their food. Kārearea aren't fussy — they don't build a nest. All they need is a scrape on the ground, a rocky outcrop, or a hollow of a tree.
