Ruru (Morepork)

Ninox novaeseelandiae





Characteristics

This large nocturnal manu is a watchful guardian of the night. The ruru is highly respected and considered by some to be a kaitiaki (guardian).

You may hear their call, which can sound like "ru-ru". Or do you hear them call: "more pork", "kou – kou", or "quork – quork" If you're lucky, you might catch a glimpse of its big yellow eyes!

Ruru are totally silent when they fly, thanks to their amazingly soft wing feathers. They are sharp listeners but sometimes get disturbed from their day roost by pīwakawaka.
