Pōhutukawa are a very significant rākau to many people in Aotearoa.


For many Māori, the rākau is associated with the journey to the afterlife.

Many call this rākau the 'New Zealand Christmas tree', as the bright red blossoms are a symbol of the summer season.



Pōhutukawa is also a name for one of the stars in the Matariki star cluster.
