Characteristics

The kākāpō is a very unique bird! It is the world's only flightless and nocturnal parrot.

Kākāpō have strong legs, strutting around the forest floor several kilometres a day!

They are also a very big manu, weighing up to nine pounds.

Male kākāpō have a low, booming voice. All kākāpō make a loud high pitched "skraak" call.
